Attending the Meeting

The Zoom meeting link, Meeting ID and Passcode are available from the Agenda that is on the parish notice boards, Shrewley Stores notice board and on the website shrewley.org prior to the meeting. Details can also be obtained by emailing the Clerk at shrewleyparish@aol.co.uk. Entering the Link will take you to the waiting room, using either a Zoom Client (if you have one installed) or via your web browser of choice. You will be admitted to the meeting from the waiting room. If you attempt to join the meeting after it has started there may be a delay in admitting you as there may be a debate in progress, you will be admitted as soon as it is practicable to do so.

Members of the Public and Press
