- The NHS dental contract, introduced in 2006, requires dentists to complete a set number of units of dental activity (UDAs) each year.
- The number of dental surgeries offering NHS treatment fell from 9,661 in 2014-2015 to 8,408 in 2019-2020
- In 2021, Health Education England published a four-year plan to develop a workforce that can support patient and population needs within the NHS and reform dental education and training
- In Wales, the Senedd Health and Social Care Committee published a report in February 2023 after undertaking an inquiry into dentistry to see whether the Welsh Government is doing enough to bridge the gap in oral health inequalities

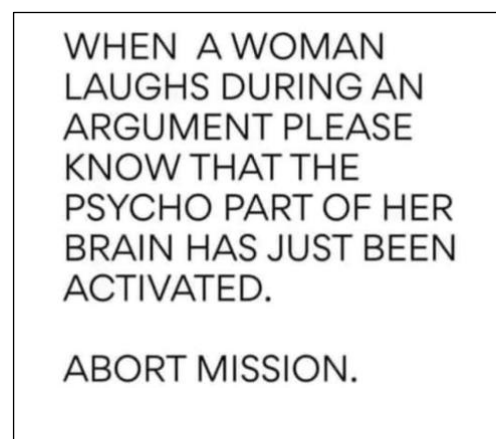
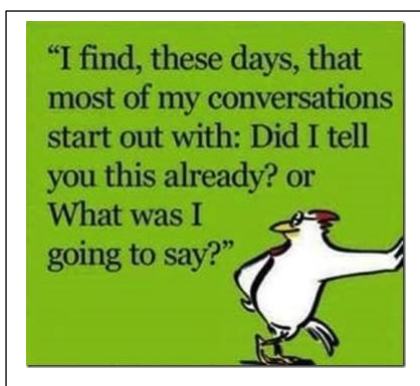
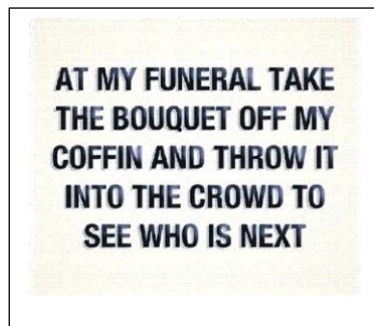
Remember that we are subsidising the subs this year so full members will pay £40.00 and dual members £15.60
